MODERN HEALTHCARE NAMES LINC HEALTH TO LIST OF TOP 20 OUTSOURCING FIRMS

Linc Also Recognized as a Top Clinical/Diagnostic Equipment Maintenance Contractor

WASHINGTON, D.C. – October 11, 2010 – Linc Health (Linc), a division of Linc Facility Services, has been ranked as one of the top 20 healthcare outsourcing firms according to *Modern Healthcare's* 2010 Outsourcing Survey.

This marks the second consecutive year that Linc Health has been named to the top 20. Rankings for the list were determined by outsourcing firms' total number of healthcare facilities. Over the past year, Linc Health increased its total number of facilities by 18% from 204 to 241 – one of the four highest percentage increases of all 20 companies listed.

“Receiving this type of recognition once again is an ongoing tribute to everyone in the Linc Health organization,” said Linc Health President Ray Zambuto. “I am pleased that our people have risen to meet the challenges of today’s economy and continued to grow the business while providing excellent service to our customers.”

The survey also named Linc as one of the seven best clinical/diagnostic equipment maintenance contractors. For this ranking, from 2008 to 2009 Linc increased its total number of facilities by 17% from 184 to 216 – the second highest percentage increase of all companies listed. Linc Health, based in Holliston, Massachusetts, specializes in facility and equipment management services.

Forty-five companies voluntarily submitted data for *Modern Healthcare's* 32nd annual survey of outsourcing activity. The survey was conducted amidst a growing trend among healthcare providers to cut expenses and maximize revenue by outsourcing functions they had kept in-house previously. In addition to the top 20 outsourcing firms, the survey also ranked the top emergency department contractors; hospital department management; information systems contractors; food service contractors; housekeeping contractors; laundry contractors; and pharmacy contractors.

“Hospitals often encounter the fact that no one person can handle all of the different types of technology,” Zambuto said. “Linc Health can train employees at a higher level than facility professionals that are trying to do it all on their own.”
