LINC FACILITY SERVICES ACQUIRES MET ELECTRICAL

Transaction Provides Complementary Mission-Critical Electrical Testing Services for LFS Mid-Atlantic Customers

The acquisition, which also includes its Substation Test Company division and Carolina Electrical Testing (CET) subsidiary, will allow LFS to provide a new level of electrical and power capabilities to its mission-critical facilities clients in Pittsburgh, Baltimore, metropolitan Washington DC, Raleigh/Durham, and Virginia's Richmond/Tidewater region, where MET has offices. All three newly-acquired companies were owned by Pepco Energy Services, a wholly owned and separately operated subsidiary of Potomac Electric Power Company.

Alexandria, Virginia, the MET acquisition further strengthens LFS's presence in the Mid-Atlantic region, and aligns perfectly with our goals to enhance our array of customer service offerings and to expand into new markets."
